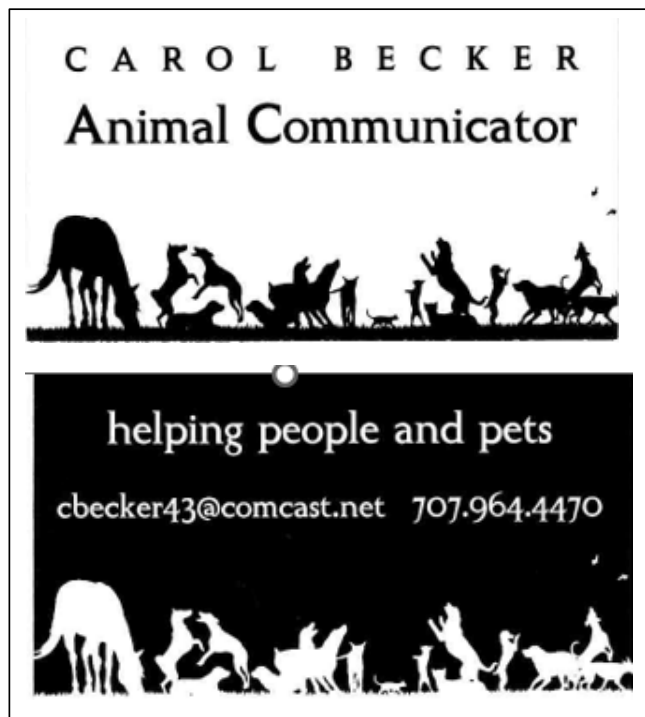

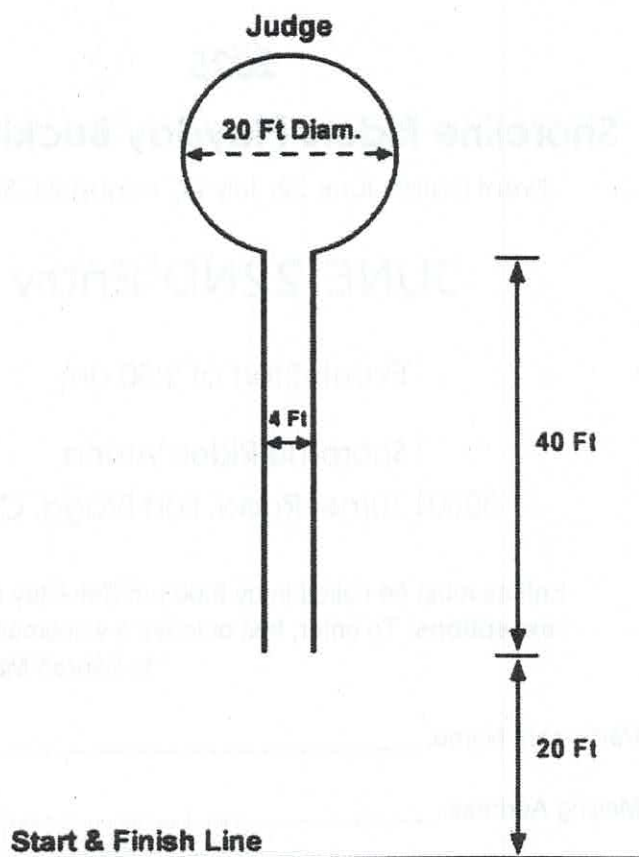


Twister
