In the March Newsletter, be looking forward to a list of chairs for each event and contact information.

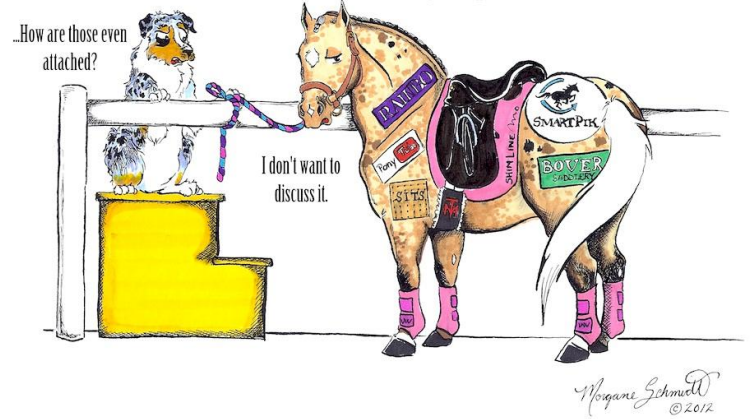

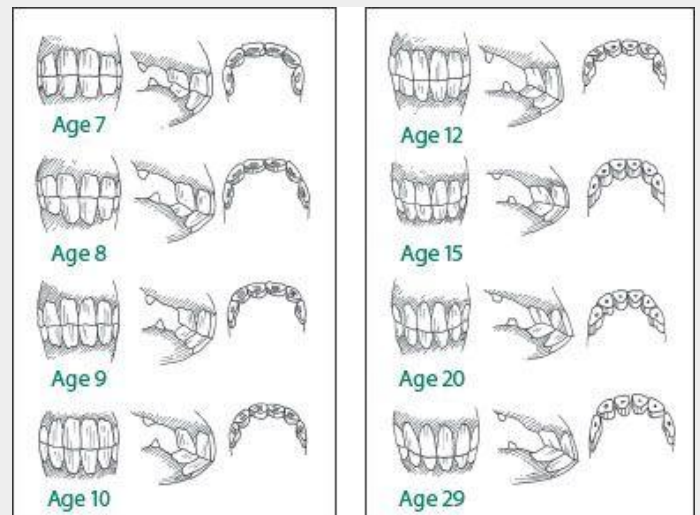
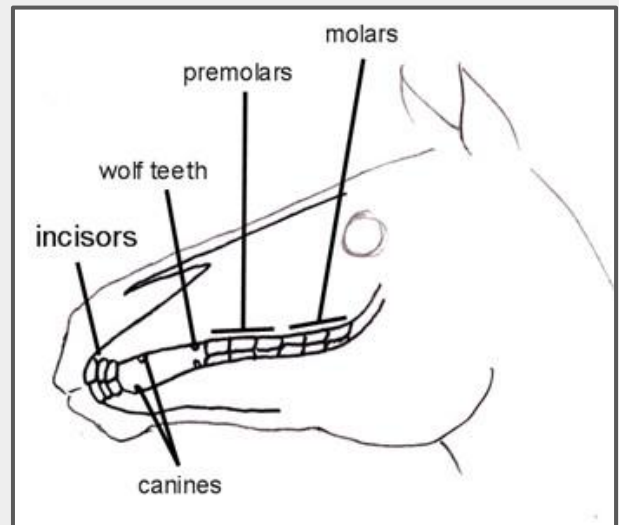

CALLED TO ORDER: 6:34 PM

APPROVAL OF MINUTES: Minutes were presented by Jill. M/Janet S/Aura approved as read.

OFFICER REPORTS:

Kelly Fairall, Treasurer; Checking account balance \$ 2,872.00 Savings account balance \$2,513.07 with regular monthly expenses presented.

COMMITTEE REPORTS:

OLD BUSINESS:

Elections: Are January 27th at 6:30 PM Members have been asked to do reminder calls/emails or text.

Membership Dues: Discussion regarding changes to the previously approved increases in the membership dues. The following changes were suggested:

Individual (1 or 2 member) New member fee \$100.00; Annual Renewal \$75.00; Late renewal fee \$25.00.
