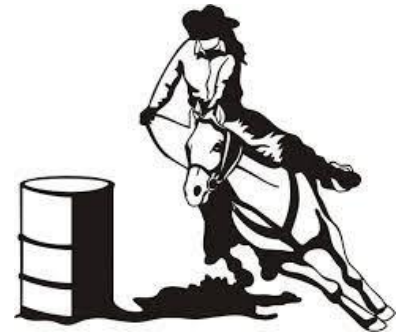

Saturday: Education stations

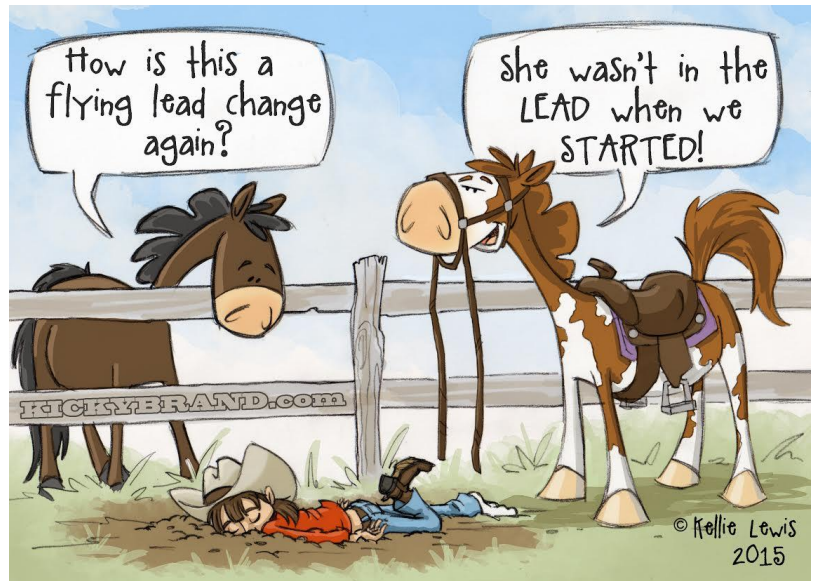
Sunday: Kids only schooling show!

KIDS HORSE CAMP & CLINIC

April 29 & 30

(one or both day options)

Objective: Participants will become familiar and confident with horses, equipment, knowledge for both care and riding of horses.

*Participants DO NOT need to own a horse to participate!

Saturday, April 29:

Clinic participants will be grouped with other similar age/experience participants and rotate through stations which will include (but not limited to): basic horse knowledge, grooming, daily care/ costs to own a horse, tack cleaning & use, groundwork and mounted riding depending on comfort of both parent and participant. Stations will be finalized based on participants' needs. Lunch will be provided for participants with a snack shack open throughout both days.

Sunday, April 30:

After the completion of Saturday's clinic, participants may enter a kids only schooling show. This show can be done on the participants' horses, a horse they have borrowed or classes will be offered using a stick horse which will be built Saturday! Ribbons will be awarded as well as end of day prizes for sportsmanship, most improved and overall cowgirl/cowboy.

KIDS HORSE CLINIC LIABILITY RELEASE:

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY, ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT – READ THIS AGREEMENT CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING IT. YOUR SIGNATURE INDICATES YOU UNDERSTAND IT AND AGREE TO ITS TERMS. BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT, YOU (AND YOUR CHILD) ARE GIVING UP CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE OR RECOVER DAMAGES IN CASE OF INJURY, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGES, FOR ANY REASON, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO THE NEGLIGENCE OF SHORELINE RIDERS INC, THE AREN, EMPLOYEES AND AGENTS (“THE RELEASEES”)

I, _____ on behalf of myself (and my minor child), _____ reside at in. _____ (Street Address) (City, State, Zip Code) In consideration for

allowing me (or my minor child) to handle and ride a horse at Shoreline Riders, INC, and on behalf of myself, my child or our personal representatives, heirs, next-of-kin, spouses and assigns, I HEREBY:

– Acknowledge that a horse, pony or mule may, without warning or any apparent cause, buck, stumble, trip, roll, fall, rear, bite, kick, run, make unpredictable movements, spook, jump obstacles, step on a person’s feet push or shove a person; saddles or bridles may loosen or break – all of which may cause the rider to fall or be jolted resulting in serious injury or death.

– ACKNOWLEDGE THAT HORSEBACK RIDING AND OTHER EQUESTRIAN ACTIVITIES ARE INHERENTLY DANGEROUS ACTIVITIES AND INVOLVE RISKS THAT MAY CAUSE SERIOUS INJURY AND IN SOME CASES, DEATH, because of the unpredictable nature and irrational behavior of horses, regardless of their training and past performance.

– Voluntarily assume the risk and danger of injury or death inherent in the handling or riding of the horse, and use of saddles, bridles, equipment and gear provided to me by the Releasees.

– Release, discharge and promise not to sue the Releasees for any loss, damage, injury (including death) or cost to my or my child’s person or property arising out of riding or handling a horse, or use of saddles, bridles, equipment and gear provided to me by the Releasees.

– Release the Releasees from any claim that such Releasees were negligent in connection with my or my child’s riding a horse, including but not limited to training or selecting horses, maintenance, care, fit or adjusting of saddles or bridges, instruction on riding skills or leading and supervising riders, which resulted in loss, damage, injury or both.

– Indemnify and save and hold harmless the Releasees from and against any loss, liability, damage or cost they may incur arising out of or in any way connected with either my or my child’s handling or riding the horse and/or use of any facilities, saddles, bridles, equipment or gear provided therewith resulting from or contributed to my own negligence.

– Expressly agree that the foregoing release and assumption of risk and indemnity agreement is governed by the laws of the State of California and is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by California law, and that in the event any portion of this Agreement is determined to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the balance of the agreement shall not be affected or impaired in any way and shall continue in full legal force and effect.

– Acknowledge that this document is a contract and agree that if a lawsuit is filed against the Releasees for any injury or damage in breach of this contract, I will pay all attorney’ fees and loss incurred by the Releasees in defending such an action.

– IT IS RECOMMENDED THAT ALL RIDERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 YEARS WEAR A PROTECTIVE HELMET.

I have read this document. I understand it is a promise to release and not to sue Shoreline Riders INC., and all employees and agents thereof, for any and all claims. I have made a free and deliberate choice to sign this Release and Waiver as a condition of Releasees allowing me or my child to ride or handle a horse. I have concluded that the risk and the release and waiver of liability are worth the pleasure of the horseback riding experience.
