Horse show: Our second show is coming up in a

MEETINGS: We will have a regular business meeting on July 23rd at 6:30 p.m. These meetings have been pretty quick and we welcome all members to join in discussion and decisions about what is happening at your club. There are usually some goodies and coffee and hot water for tea or chocolate.

Remember we are members only club so even those who are giving or taking lessons, having group sessions, etc. all participants must be a current member or pay the day member fee. Forms and rosters are in the hallway and on our members only facebook page if you need them.

BOUNTY BULL: New this year we are having a Bounty Bull at the rodeo. The high scoring bull rider each day will have a chance to ride the bounty bull for an extra \$500 if he makes the 8 seconds. If the bull wins Saturday the Sunday ride will be worth \$1000. There will also be a \$250 per day raffle drawing for the audience. Fort Bragg Feed and Pet will be sponsoring the Bounty and we will be selling tickets for the drawing just before and at the rodeo.

A couple of things to remember now that our events have begun. It is wonderful to see everyone out there having such a good time. Please be safe, continue with the fabulous encouragement and have FUN!

1) Minor children must have a legal parent/guardian on the grounds during open events. If you cannot be there you must have an original signed and dated note designating a present guardian with emergency contact info at the booth. Just like school!

2) Parking can be tight. Please leave a 10 ft drive through near the front field and pull your trailers all the way up equal to the edge of the holding pen by the arena. We can fit two trailers in a row if you pull up to the "road" area. Opening the contestant gate off of Turner Rd also helps.

3) No horses or people huddling near the gate! Keep the gate entrance area CLEAR! You can watch and video from the bleachers and wait your turn back from the gate.

4) No horses (or people) walking around the outside of the arena (the back road, the back field and the obstacle area) as it causes distractions and sometimes spookiness. This is so all contestants are riding the same course with the same conditions. If you need the round pen check with the booth first.

5) Committees please be sure to empty all outside garbage and recycle cans, clean the bathrooms, put away all equipment and lock up before you go.

If you have any questions, issues or need information please feel free to contact any of the officers or board members for help.

If you haven't joined our members only group on Facebook please do. We try to post forms, events and important announcements there as much as possible. There are also some good articles and entertaining quips posted from time to time.

Playdays: We have had two of our four playdays so far. Great group of riders and workers. They are competing for End of the Series Buckles and other great prizes. Look for the next playday coming up August 11th starting at 9:30 a.m. Remember to sign up by the Saturday before and if you have changes or can't make it please message Aura so she knows. There was a lot of confusion in the booth at the last event with horse and rider changes, late comers and people not signing up ahead of time. SRI ground rules are posted and must be followed.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times.

Classes with fewer than 3 participants may be
combined with another class or canceled.

Decisions of the judges are final. Any high point tie will be
decided by highest Showmanship placing.
